



Christof Gabriel Maetze

Christof Maetze has been Senior Advisor in the Financial Institutions Practice Area at THE BOSTON CONSULTING GROUP in Brussels and Munich since October 2017. He also holds three international supervisory board mandates as Member of the General Council (Chairman of the Audit Committee) at Hellenic Financial Stability Fund (Athens) with a volume of almost € 45 billion, as Deputy Chairman of the Supervisory Board (Chairman of the Audit Committee) at Access Holding Microfinance AG (Berlin) and as a member of the Independent Expert Oversight Advisory Committee at the World Health Organization (Geneva).

From 2007 to 2017, Christof Maetze was responsible as a divisional director of Commerzbank AG for the customer group of banks, capital accumulation points, central banks and selected corporate customers in the product area transaction banking worldwide with representative offices in 40 countries. He succeeded in placing Commerzbank as market leader in foreign trade business in Germany among the top 3 banks in Europe.

As a member of the Executive Committee of the Corporate Bank, Christof Maetze worked for Dresdner Bank AG from 2004 to 2006. Prior to that he worked for 13 years at HypoVereinsbank AG. As Division and Branch Manager, he was responsible for foreign customer service for Asia, built up the Singapore branch and was project manager during the merger of Bayerische Vereinsbank and Hypo-Bank.

Christof Maetze started his career in 1985 as a consultant for international corporate clients at BHF-Bank, where he also completed his banking degree at the Frankfurt School of Finance and Management in 1989. Prior to this, he completed his training as a banker at Commerzbank in Wuppertal from 1981 to 1984.

In addition to extensive management experience in strategic matters, Christof Maetze has also successfully completed a training as a business mediator in Munich in 2016.
